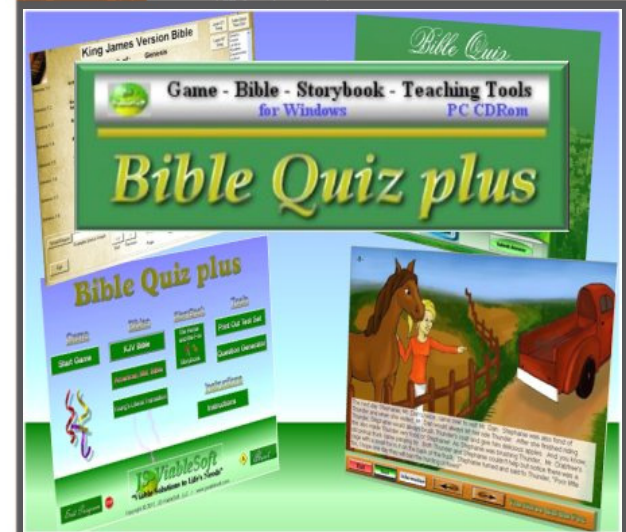

For Children ages 3 – 5 use:
The Bible song module and learn by singing the books of the Bible.

For Children ages 6 – up use:
The Bibles and the Quiz modules to read the Bible and be tested for rewards.

How to implement the plan

- Set aside one day of the week to spend 30 minutes with your child or family for spiritual growth.
- During the first meeting to start the plan, talk to your child or family about the importance of learning the Bible and how God requires us to study his word in order to direct our lives.
- Be sure to stay on the weekly 30 minute schedule to help you and your family develop confidence in what you are doing.

The Results

- Read Romans the 8th chapter, it sums it up
- Galations 5:22 – 23: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance.

STEP BY STEP PROGRESSION

Children ages 3 – 5 (or anyone)

- 1) Sit with your child at the PC or at your multimedia television. Click on the KJV or AMS Bible from the main menu.
 - 2) Tell your child you want them to sing the Books of the Bible song with them.
 - 3) Click on the Learn OT Song button on the top right and let your child listen to the song. As the song progresses use the hand cursor and show your child or family the books as they are being sung.
 - 4) Tell your child you want them to learn the books of the Old Testament song so you can sing it together once they have learned it. Tell them you will sit with them each week and see how they have progressed.
 - 5) **Reward** your child with treats as they progress so he/she will be encouraged to continue learning
 - 6) **After** your child has learned the Old Testament song do the same with the New Testament song.
- This is self-paced so there is no time constraint

Children ages 6 – up (or anyone)

- 1) Tell your child you have a deep conviction of making sure they are given the opportunity to learn God's word for themselves, so they are aware of just what it takes for God's blessings and favor to be on their lives.
- 2) Tell them you would like to spend 30 minutes a week with them and talk about the goodness of God.

- 3) Introduce them to Bible Quiz Plus and show them how the program works.
- 4) Tell them you want them to begin with the first book of the Bible (Genesis) and eventually read through the complete Bible, at their own pace.

- 5) Tell your child you want to play one quiz game a week with them and if they beat you, they get a bonus reward.
- 6) Each week before you play the quiz with your child check with them on their progression on reading the Bible.
- 7) As your child progresses in their reading of the Bible, use the question generator and create a quiz on the books and chapters they have completed.

Note:

- Increase the Bible challenges only as your child becomes comfortable at the level in which they are progressing.
- In order to keep your older child/children encouraged and motivated, you might want to give them rewards in the form of additional allowance or other monetary things.
